United States Justice Department Implements Relativity for E-Discovery Review and Advanced Text Analytics

Press Release – Chicago, IL, and Washington DC – April 14, 2011 – kCura, developers of the e-discovery software Relativity, announced with TechLaw Solutions today that the Executive Office for U.S. Attorneys (EOUSA), a component of the U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), has adopted Relativity for the review and analysis of electronic and paper-based documents. Analysis capabilities include advanced text analytics through the Relativity Analytics feature set.
